WHAT DO WE DO ALL WEEK?

First we will all learn about SAFETY! Riding and working around horses can be a wonderful yet dangerous experience if certain safety rules are not followed. Our goal is to teach each camper not only safety but also horsemanship. They will learn to respect these beautiful animals while having a lot of FUN.

We are one of the largest equestrian centers in Northampton County celebrating **over 20 years** of Happy Campers. We use the same horses all of our students use all year round. We know these horses very well. We have a 4:1 student counselor ration, so everyone is closely supervised. Our counselors will be assisted by some of our show team students and Jr. Staff providing a 1:1 ratio if needed to make even the most timid student feel comfortable. You must still remember that even the best horses can be

unpredictable, so BE CAREFUL! We will learn SAFETY RULES at camp before we ride.

The following information will help you to know what to bring and how to dress.

1. Bring your own lunch preferably in a small cooler.
2. You may want to bring a jug of water.
3. Wear LONG PANTS and shoes or boots with a hard sole and small heel. NO OPEN SHOES ARE PERMITTED. T-shirts are fine.
4. Wear sunscreen and you may want to bring some to reapply.
5. Riding Helmets will be worn during all mounted instructions. If you have a riding helmet, bring it. If you do not have a riding helmet, a bicycle helmet that fits properly and stays in place can be worn.
6. Please label all of your belongings.
7. Our Camper Skills Demonstration will be held on Friday 1:30 to 2:30

NOW FOR THE FUN STUFF!!!

This is a basic outline of what will be covered during the day. You will be assigned a group according to your riding experience, (if you have never been on a horse, that's OK!) You will be receiving handouts which you can take home. You will be learning hands-on with real horses and not just with a piece of paper. Each day you will have a 1 to 1 1/2 hour riding session. We play games, do crafts and even enjoy a slip and slide and water games on those hot days on the farm.

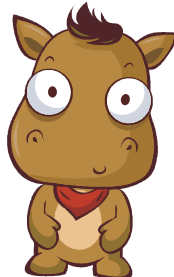
